In-line with our Safeguarding Policy and in accordance with the British Council's guidelines, we have a duty of care to protect our young learners (12 – 17) and as you are legally an adult at 18 years of age in the UK, we have certain rules that you must adhere to during your time at Mackenzie School.

- Toilets for our over 18s are located downstairs, next to the resource room, or on the first floor next to room 3. Please **do not use the student toilets**.
- During break times you should **not mix with students under the age of 16**. This does not mean you cannot talk to them! It is important that you are not spending time alone with younger students as it is not appropriate.
- Outside the school premises (walking home, on the bus, free time in the city centre) **do not socialise with students under 16 years' old**.
- You **cannot drink alcohol** while you are a student at Mackenzie School of English. We understand that you might already drink at home but we have a **zero alcohol policy** you must respect.
- Please respect the curfew whilst staying with our hosts. If you break curfew, you may be moved to alternative accommodation at your/your parents expense.
- When you have free time, you **cannot** visit the city centre **by yourself in the evenings**. The school is open for you to spend time with your friends and your Group Leader may decide to organise a group excursion in the evenings.

The school will perform **checks on all adult students** to ensure they are following these rules. If these rules are broken you will be in breach of contract and you will be asked to leave the school.
